



Money BALL DROP – Rules
2019 Hankin Invitational
Whitford Country Club
1:00 pm
Monday, October 7, 2019

1. The Contest: For a suggested minimum donation of \$20 per golf ball, 6 balls for \$100. a person, age 18 or older, will be entered in Handi-Crafters Money Ball Drop Contest to take place during the 33rd Annual Hankin Invitational on October 7, 2019 at approximately 1:00 pm at Whitford Country Club, Exton, PA. Participants may enter more than once. Participants will be assigned a numbered golf ball (maximum of 1000) for each raffle ticket purchased at www.handi-crafters.org
2. The Drop: All purchased numbered golf balls will be placed randomly into a container and dropped from an Haulotte HA80-JRT BOOM LIFT from a height of approximately 80 feet onto the assigned target. The participant whose ball goes into the cup/hole will be declared the first prize winner of the Golf Ball Drop and be awarded first prize as outlined below.
3. Prizes: The grand prize shall be awarded \$1,000. All prizes are subject to rules outlined below.
4. Rules: The ball landing in the cup/hole will be declared the First Prize Winner, and will receive the top prize of \$1000. If two/multiple golf ball land in the cup/hole, the independent judges will determine that there is a tie among these balls, then each ball will be declared a winner and the prize of \$1000 will be shared/split equally among these winners. If NO golf ball lands in the cup/hole there will be NO \$1000 prize winner. The participant whose ball lands closest to the cup/hole will be declared the closest to the cup/hole winner, and will receive the \$500 prize, as determined by the independent judges. The winner is determined by the measurement of the golf balls from the hole. The ball measured farthest from the pin will win \$500.
5. Announcement of Prize Winners: The winners need not be present to win. The winners will be announced immediately following the Golf Ball Drop. The names of the winners will also be posted on the Handi-Crafters web site post event page.
6. Alternative Process: If some unforeseen event prevents Handi-Crafters from being able to conduct the Golf Ball Drop as outlined above then the winners will be determined by the following alternative process: The Golf Ball Drop will take place if the tournament is postponed to the raindate of Monday, October 14, 2019. Should the event be cancelled, within a week of the scheduled event, all purchased Golf Balls will be placed into a container and an independent judge selected by the organizers will draw the winner (first ball to be drawn will be the grand prize, followed by 2nd and 3rd prizes)
7. Purchasing GOLF BALLS: Golf Ball will be available for sale at <https://www.handi-crafters.org>, the official site for Handi-Crafters (the beneficiary) and the Hankin Invitational tournament registration. Handi-Crafters is located at: 215 Barley Sheaf Road, Thorndale PA. Suggested donations for each



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golf ball are: \$20 for 1 ticket, \$100 for 6. Donations. Purchases are non-refundable. Golf Balls will be available for sale until approximately Noon on the day of the 33rd Annual Hankin Invitational. (October 7, 2019)

8. Tracking Tickets: Handi-Crafters Development Director shall be responsible for maintaining the list of golf balls sold and the name, address, email and telephone number of the purchaser of each ball, and have that list available for auditing and inspection to insure the openness and integrity of the Money Ball Drop.

9. Notification of Winner: If the winner is not present at the time of the golf ball drop, then the winner will be notified by email, telephone and/or US Postal mail. If the winner cannot be located or fails to claim the prize within thirty (30) days after notification, the prize will be forfeited and awarded to the next winner in line as specified in the rules above.

10. Forfeiting of Prize: If no winner comes forth after attempting to contact the three separate, sequential winners as provided in the rules above, then the prize will be forfeited to Handi-Crafters to be used in support of its mission.

12. Miscellaneous:

- a. Odds of winning depend on the number of valid entries (up to 1000) received by the deadline set forth above.
- b. All federal, state and local taxes are the sole responsibility of the individual winner.
- c. The funds raised at this event will be used to support the programs of the Handi-Crafters, a not-for-profit corporation, registered 501(c)(3)
- d. Decisions by the Golf Ball Drop Independent Judges on all aspects of the raffle will be binding and final.
- e. The prize will not be awarded, and will be forfeited, if the ticket was issued in exchange for a donation by check returned for "insufficient funds" or by a credit card charge deemed "declined", "invalid", or "stolen."
